Dewaine's Tractor Rides 2022

Thursday:

On Thursday, you will come to the Richland County Fairgrounds based out of Richland Center to unload your tractors and sign in with me. Sign-in starts at 10 am and will end at 5:30 pm, but if you are earlier or later than those specific times that is perfectly okay. There will be guys outside helping direct you and answer any questions about unloading and parking tractors. I will be inside the building on the left of where the tractors will be parked which will be marked by a sign or balloons. Once you come inside, we will sign you in and give you your bag. Inside the bag will be your t-shirt, route maps, meal tickets, itinerary, extra information, and some local information. You will be asked to provide proof of insurance at sign-in. Also, this is where you can sign up for the group that you will be riding in. There will also be a driver's meeting at 5:30 pm in that same building.

Friday:

On Friday, the first group will be leaving the fairgrounds at 8 am, with each group leaving 15 minutes apart. This is going to be the west route and will be the pink highlighted map from your bag. The first stop is 14 miles from the fairgrounds at the Durst Dairy Farms. Our lunch stop, which is 17 miles from the morning stop, for the day will be in Boaz at a park shelter with the food being catered by Dionne Cary who is from the area. We will then loop back around for 19 miles before coming back to Boaz for the final stop at the Lonesome Dove Bar and Grill. The last stretch of the route is 11 miles where we will then be right back to the fairgrounds for you to get gas, park, visit, etc. There will be about 3-4 patches of gravel that we will ride on in this route.

Saturday:

For the Saturday route, which is the orange highlighted map, the first group will leave at 7:30 am, with each group leaving 15 minutes apart. We moved up the time for Saturday since it is always nice to get back to the fairgrounds earlier on the last day so everyone can get home if they want. The groups will stay the same for each day, but the times will change just a bit. So, if you are in the second group then on Friday you would be leaving at 8:15 am and on Saturday you would leave at 7:45 am. It is 14 miles to Muscoda which is where our morning stop is being held at Honkers Dining, Lodging, and Spirits. Our lunch stop for the day is 19 miles from the first stop and is in Lone Rock at The Woods Bar and Grill. The afternoon stop is in Bear Valley at the Copperhead Road Bar which is 13 miles from Lone Rock. The last stretch of the route is 15 miles

and will end up right back at the fairgrounds for you to load up, get gas, visit, etc. This route may have one small patch of gravel that we ride on.
